

Steubenville STL Mid-America is a high-energy youth conference in which teens are invited to encounter Jesus Christ through dynamic speakers, engaging music, the Sacraments, small group discussions, and fellowship with other teens. Our conferences are an outreach of Franciscan University in partnership with the St. Louis Archdiocesan Office of Youth Ministry. Two conferences are held every year in July and take place on the campus of Missouri State University in Springfield, MO.

CONFERENCE INFORMATION

Group Leader:

The Group Leader is the individual organizing the trip for their group or parish. The Group Leader must be 21 years old and attending the conference weekend. All correspondence and planning, prior to the conference, will take place between this individual and the Office of Youth Ministry. When registering, the Group Leader will register as a "chaperone".

Chaperones:

Chaperones must be 21 years of age and in compliance with their home Diocesan Child Protection Policies. (It is the responsibility of the Group Leader to ensure that all chaperones are in compliance). Chaperones should be prepared and able to walk long distances across campus, handle loud music in the sessions and keep up with active youth. The Office of Youth Ministry requires 1 chaperone for every 8 youth, per gender and no more than 1 chaperone for every 4 youth.

Priests:

We encourage all groups to invite your parish priest to attend. Any priest who attends and is willing to hear confessions will be admitted to the conference for FREE. We coordinate priest housing and house all priests off campus in a nearby hotel. Priests must register online with your group and submit a Certificate of Aptitude to the Springfield-Cape Girardeau diocese.

Young Adults:

Young adults are individuals who are between the ages of 18 and 21 and past the summer after their senior year of high school. There can be no more than 1 young adult for every 10 teen participants. Young adults must also be in compliance with their home Diocesan Child Protection Policies

Teen Participants:

Participants may range from incoming freshman (entering 9th grade in August of 2022) through graduated seniors (graduated in May of 2022).

Young Children:

With the best care of the teen participants in mind, children and infants are not allowed. All Group Leaders and Chaperones must be made aware of this policy. Although we strongly support Catholic family life, our staffing, facility constraints, and insurance regulations do not allow us to provide for children and infants on the campus.



GROUPS

All participants must register and attend the conference with a group. Groups are defined as one adult leader with one or more youth participants. No single registrations will be accepted.

STEUBENVILLE STL MID-AMERICA 2022 IMPORTANT DATES

FEBRUARY 17: GROUP REGISTRATION

Group Registration opens online at 10:00 AM CST. Instructions can be found at steubystl.com.

MARCH 3: DEPOSITS DUE

A non-transferable, non-refundable \$50.00 deposit, per spot, is due.

For groups who register after February 17th, all deposits are due 10 business days after initial registration.

MARCH 24: SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE

The application and further info can be found at steubystl.com.

APRIL 21: FINAL DROP DAY

The Office of Youth Ministry must be notified of any dropped spots by Thursday, April 21st. After this date each group will be financially responsible for the entire cost of all remaining spots for which they registered.

MAY 5: FINAL PAYMENT DUE

The remaining payment is due on May 5th. The final bill will be sent to Group Leaders immediately following the Drop Date. The group will be financially responsible for the spots originally registered for unless adjusted by the April 21st Drop Date.

*All late payments will be charged a 10% late fee.

JUNE 2: FORMS DUE

All room lists, optional t-shirt, and lunch order forms are due.

JUNE 16: ONLINE REGISTRATION DUE

Any participants who have not registered online before June 16th at 9:00 AM will have an extended wait during on-site registration on the Friday of the conference.

DOS AND DON'TS OF REGISTRATION

DO have a commitment from your participants before purchasing spots DO be ready for when registration goes live at 10am on February 17th DO check the FAQs on steubystl.com if you have a question.

DON'T register for more spots than you have financial commitment for DON'T register for both weekends to hold spots only to then back out later.


DON'T panic if your registration status is "waitlist". The OYM will reach out to you as soon as possible with available options.

- If the Conference is canceled by us or a governmental agency, all groups will be refunded 100% of their money.
- If the Conference is not canceled but your group, or member of your group, chooses not to attend, there will be no refund.
- All payments are non-refundable and non-transferrable unless the conference is canceled by us or a governmental agency.
