On Campus Option

Group Leader

The Group Leader is the individual organizing the trip for their group or parish. The Group Leader must be 21 years old and attending the conference weekend. All correspondence and planning, prior to the conference, will take place between this individual and the Office of Youth Ministry. When registering, the Group Leader will register as a "chaperone" and should be included in the chaperone count.

Young Adults

Young adults are individuals who are between the ages of 18 and 21 and past the summer after their senior year of high school. Young adults must also be in compliance with their home Diocesan Child Protection Policies.

Priests

We encourage all groups to invite your parish priest to attend. Any priest who attends and is willing to hear confessions will be admitted to the conference for FREE. We coordinate priest housing and house all priests off campus in a nearby hotel, two to a room. Priests must register online with your group and submit a Certificate of Aptitude to the Springfield-Cape Girardeau Diocese.

Teens

Participants may range from incoming freshman (entering 9th grade in August of 2024) through graduated seniors (graduated in May of 2024).

Chaperones

Chaperones must be 21 years of age and in compliance with their home Diocesan Child Protection Policies. (It is the responsibility of the Group Leader to ensure that all chaperones are in compliance). Chaperones should be prepared and able to walk long distances across campus, handle loud music in the sessions and keep up with active youth. The Office of Youth Ministry requires 1 chaperone for every 8 youth, per gender and no more than 1 chaperone for every 4 youth. Each group must have at least 2 chaperones, even if the group is less than 8 youth.



Conference Information

Please inform the Office of Youth Ministry as soon as possible if an individual in your group may require any special accommodations. The sooner we are aware, the better we may be able to accommodate the needs.

Special Accomoda -tions



Groups All participants must register and attend the conference with a group. Groups are defined as one adult leader with one or more youth participants. No single registrations will be accepted.

Meals



All payments are non-refundable and non-transferable unless the conference is canceled by us or a governmental agency. If the Conference is not canceled but your group, or member of your group, chooses not to attend, there will be no refund. You may fill any paid empty spot with a participant up until the time of the conference.
